Doorway relies on volunteers, the Friends of Doorway and donations to ensure that we continue to provide a drop-in centre for homeless and marginalised adults at The Salvation Army Hall, Chippenham.

We believe that future survival depends on engaging with our local community by raising awareness of the benefits of what we are doing for everyone in terms of public safety – not just benefits for our guests.

## Friends of Doorway

Friends of Doorway is a self-supporting team of volunteers in the community who give time, energy or resources to raise the profile of Doorway in North Wiltshire and to generate much needed funds.

Roles of the Friends include:

- Organise fundraising events .
- Ambassadors for Doorway who will join our Speakers Group and talk at local events, schools, groups about our work.
- Assist with the promotion of Doorway by distributing leaflets and setting up exhibitions in local public places.

## Donations

We need donations of food and clothing for our guests to take away from the drop-in centre.

We also need donations of money. Doorway needs in the region of £90,000 a year to keep going (not counting the contribution in kind from The Salvation Army) - charitable trusts and statutory bodies are reluctant to fund running costs year after year.

Doorway is therefore aiming to become more self-sufficient in the future.

## Recycling

Recycling your used inkjet, laser printer cartridges and mobile phones through Doorway will help us to secure the drop-in's financial future at no cost to yourselves.

Through our partnership with Recycling Appeal we could earn £1 for every used printer cartridge and up to £25 for every used mobile phone donated on our behalf.

Doorway can provide recycling boxes for your business premises or freepost envelopes if you are an individual.
